We recently participated in a scheduled meeting with Fitch & Associates as part of Greenville County Council's ongoing Fire Service Study. Attending the meeting were myself, Andrea, and Commissioner Bagwell.

The meeting was very informative and, overall, went better than expected. In addition to the formal discussion, several sidebar conversations with participants and information gathered during the recent town hall-style meeting helped provide additional perspective on the study's direction.

One key takeaway from these discussions is that full countywide consolidation of fire services does not appear to be a feasible solution for a county as large and complex as Greenville County. The size, service demands, and operational differences across the county present significant challenges to a single consolidated model.

We will continue to monitor the progress of the study and participate in discussions to ensure the interests of our department and community are well represented as recommendations move forward.

It has already been another busy month. Members of our department attended the funeral of retired Captain Quinn's father, and as of this writing, we have learned that his mother also passed away yesterday (March 8, 2026). Our thoughts and prayers remain with Captain Quinn and his family during this difficult time.

Looking ahead, we will be participating in the St. Patrick's Day parade downtown this Saturday, along with several additional community events scheduled throughout the remainder of the month.

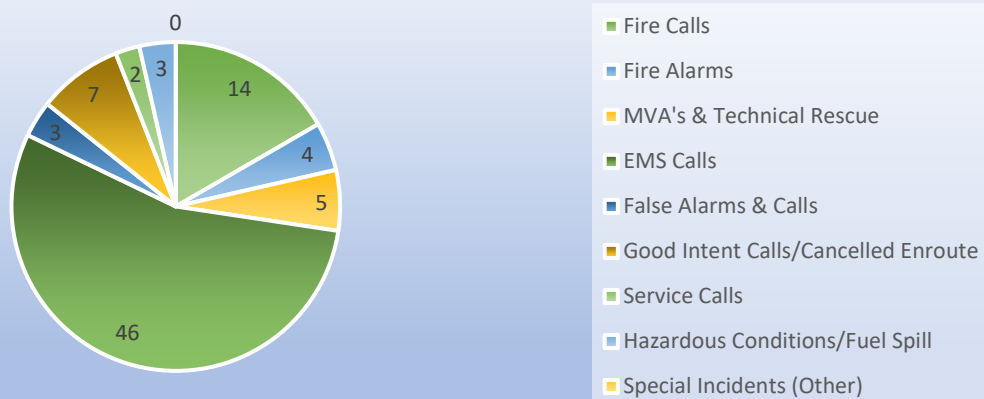
