As we continue with our normal daily duties within the department, a few extra things are also being completed. We received our forcible entry prop, and it's being utilized daily. Bob continues to do a great job with the training division. Gary continues to complete the New Fire Chief classes as offered by the Firefighters Association and Chiefs Association.

I've meet with Pope, Flynn on the contract presented by the City of Greenville and discussed our thoughts and needs.

The State and FEMA have approved the administration reimbursement from Hurricane Helene. We're working on getting them everything they need to receive our funds.

Legislatively, Senator Roger Nutt resigned due to being diagnosed with Alzheimer's. House Member Bobby Cox resigned his position and will run for Nutt's Seat, and his open seat will be on the ballot at the same time.

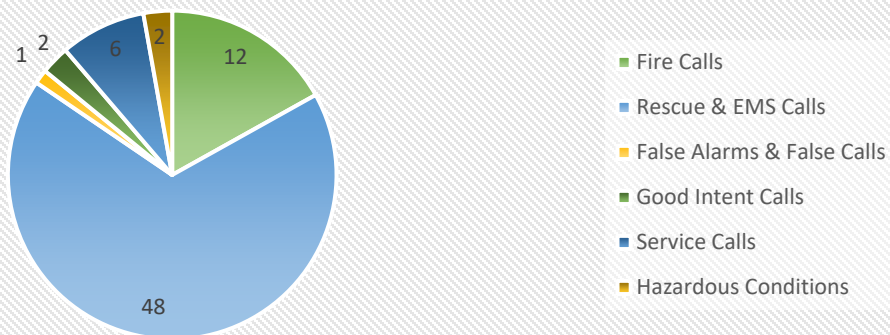

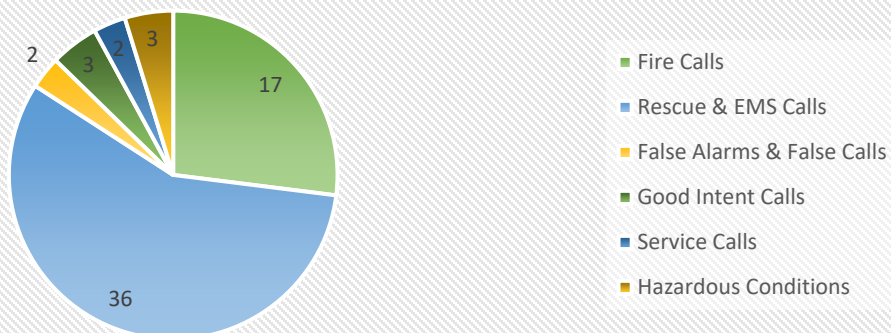
