a. March 30, 2023-Regular Scheduled Meeting

Item (6) 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget 2nd Reading

a. The Commission discussed the 2023-2024 Proposed Salary Increase and asked Chief Segars how each increase would affect the budget. The Chief presented a worksheet (Included on the March 30, 2023 Minutes). that shows the effect of each percentage increase on the fiscal year 2023-2024 salary total. The worksheet includes a no increase to a 2%, 3%, 4% and 5% increases. The board discussed what a 3% or 4% increase would incur to the station compared to what the cost is presently. They agreed that 4% was a good increase in budget terms and in economic terms for the employees.

<u>Action:</u> Commissioner Bagwell made a motion to increase the Salaries by 4%, Commissioner Cass seconded the motion all were in favor (5,0).

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<u>Action:</u> Commissioner Shirley made a motion to approve the second reading of the July 2023- June 2024 Fiscal Year Budget with the amended 4% Salary increase, Commissioner Merrill seconded the motion, all were in favor (5,0).

This plan is in the development and planning stage and needs to be quoted.
