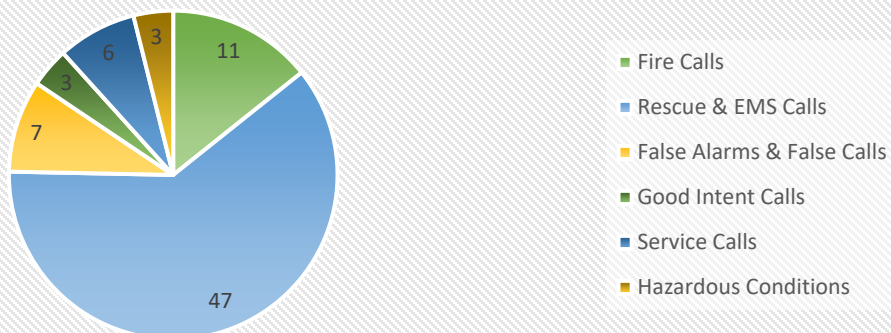


Incident Type Count for Date Range
